Meaning: A-TIPTOE: adverb meaning to walk on the tips of one's toes, often in a quiet or stealthy manner.

3. He edged a-tiptoe along the narrow ledge, his heart pounding in his chest.

6. They proceeded a-tiptoe down the creaky stairs, hoping to surprise their parents.
