

ABALIENATE

Meaning: Abalienate means to cause someone to feel estranged or disconnected from a group or relationship.

1. The new policy seemed to abalienate many long-time employees who felt unsupported.
2. Her constant criticism began to abalienate her friends, leaving her feeling isolated.
3. Efforts to modernize the community center were met with resistance that threatened to abalienate local residents.
