

# ABATABLE

*Meaning: Abatable refers to a penalty or consequence that can be reduced or eliminated under certain conditions.*

1. The penalty for the violation is abatable if the offender shows remorse.
2. In some legal cases, penalties are considered abatable under specific conditions.
3. The landlord agreed that the rent increase was abatable due to the poor maintenance of the property.
4. If the circumstances change significantly, the contract may be deemed abatable.
5. Certain tax levies are abatable if the taxpayer submits the necessary documentation.
6. The judge ruled that the sentence was abatable given the defendant's clean record.
7. The committee discussed whether the funding cut was abatable based on the project's success.
8. Many fines are abatable if they are paid within a specified timeframe.
9. The terms of the agreement included a clause stating that certain fees were abatable.
10. After reviewing the evidence, the board found the complaint to be abatable.
