6. His promotion was held in abeyance as the company reevaluated its staffing needs.
7. The treaty negotiations are currently in abeyance, leaving the future uncertain.
8. After the scandal, the organization kept its leadership changes in abeyance.
9. The proposal is in abeyance, awaiting approval from the board of directors.
10. Her position on the committee is in abeyance until her eligibility is confirmed.
