

ABIRRITATE

Meaning: Abirritate: to irritate or annoy someone further, especially in a way that exacerbates an existing discomfort or tension.

2. His sarcastic remarks only served to abirritate the already tense atmosphere in the room.
3. Children often abirritate their parents with endless questions about the world around them.
