

ABRIDGE

Meaning: To abridge means to shorten or condense a text or presentation while retaining its essential meaning or content.

1. The editor decided to abridge the lengthy manuscript to make it more accessible to readers.
2. To save time, she chose to abridge her presentation by focusing on the key points.
3. His goal was to abridge the classic novel into a short story for younger audiences.
4. The committee asked the author to abridge the research paper for the conference proceedings.
