

ABSTENTION

Meaning: Abstention refers to the act of deliberately choosing not to participate in a vote or decision.

1. Her abstention from voting surprised many of her colleagues.
2. The committee reached a decision despite one member's abstention.
3. During the debate, his abstention was seen as a tacit endorsement of the proposal.
4. Abstention from certain foods can lead to significant health improvements.
