

ACCEDE

Meaning: Accede: to agree to a request or demand, often after careful consideration or negotiation.

1. The committee decided to accede to the demands of the protesters after hours of negotiation.
2. Despite initial resistance, the country chose to accede to the terms of the peace treaty.
3. After much deliberation, he agreed to accede to her request for additional funding.
4. The board members were hesitant but ultimately decided to accede to the CEO's proposal.
5. In order to maintain harmony, the leaders agreed to accede to the suggestions made by the experts.
6. She was reluctant at first but eventually chose to accede to the group's decision.
7. The government might accede to international pressure to improve human rights conditions.
