*Meaning: Acceder means to agree to a request or demand, often after some reluctance or negotiation.*

1. I had to accede to her request for more time to complete the project.
2. After much debate, the committee decided to accede to the proposal for a new community center.
3. He was reluctant to accede to their demands, but ultimately he had no choice.
4. To move forward, we must accede to the terms laid out in the agreement.
5. The government may accede to public pressure regarding environmental regulations.
6. In order to maintain a peaceful relationship, she chose to accede to his wishes.
7. They were surprised when the company decided to accede to the union's demands.
8. The board members realized they needed to accede to the shareholder's concerns.
9. Acceding to the new guidelines will help streamline the process significantly.
10. She felt it was important to accede to the cultural norms of her new community.
