

ACCESSORIAL

Meaning: ACCESSORIAL (adjective): relating to or denoting a person or thing that is secondary or supplementary to a main charge or offense, often involved in facilitating or aiding the principal crime.

1. The judge ruled that the evidence was accessory to the main charge.
2. In the legal context, accessory crimes often carry lesser penalties than the principal offense.
3. The designer added accessorial elements to the outfit, enhancing its overall appeal.
