

ACCIACCATURA

Meaning: Acciaccatura is a musical ornament consisting of a grace note that is played quickly before the main note, adding expressiveness to a piece.

1. Acciaccatura adds a unique flair to classical music pieces.

3. In the score, the composer indicated an acciaccatura before the main note.
