Meaning: ACCOMPLICITY: the state of being involved with others in an illegal activity or wrongdoing.

1. Her complicity in the scheme was revealed during the investigation.
2. The evidence suggested that his complicity extended beyond mere negligence.

4. They were charged with complicity in the crime, despite not being the primary perpetrators.
