4. After the game, the player was accosted by fans seeking autographs and photos.
5. While shopping, she was accosted by a salesperson who was overly eager to make a sale.
6. They were accosted by a demanding customer who wanted to speak to the manager.
7. As soon as he stepped out of the bar, he was accosted by a homeless man asking for change.
8. During the event, she was accosted by several individuals wanting to share their opinions.
9. The politician was accosted by reporters as he exited the building to answer questions.
10. He was accosted on the street by someone trying to sell him a subscription service.
