Meaning: ACIDIFY: to make or become acidic, often through the addition of an acid or a chemical reaction.

1. The process of fermentation can help to acidify the mixture, enhancing its flavor.
2. When exposed to carbon dioxide, water can acidify and form carbonic acid.
3. The addition of lemon juice will acidify the dish and balance its sweetness.
