

ADJOURNAL

Meaning: ADJOURNAL (verb): to suspend or end a meeting or session temporarily, with the intention of resuming it at a later time.

1. The committee decided to adjourn the meeting until further notice.
2. After a lengthy discussion, they chose to adjourn and reconvene next week.
3. The judge ordered the court to adjourn due to the lack of available witnesses.
4. We must adjourn this session to ensure everyone can participate fully.
5. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the conference will adjourn until next month.
6. The team agreed to adjourn their planning session to gather more data.
7. It is customary to adjourn the proceedings when all members have spoken.
8. They decided to adjourn rather than rush through the important issues.
9. The speaker announced they would adjourn the lecture for a brief intermission.
10. As the hour grew late, the organizers chose to adjourn the event for the day.
