

ADMOVE

Meaning: Admove: to transfer or advance something, such as a legal case or an argument, to a different context or level for further consideration or discussion.

1. The lawyer decided to admove the case to a higher court for further consideration.
2. In her presentation, she chose to admove her argument about the environmental impact of the proposal.
3. During the meeting, the committee members agreed to admove the discussion to the next session.
4. The professor will admove the topic of ethics in her upcoming lecture series.
5. He plans to admove the agenda item regarding budget cuts to the end of the meeting.
6. The director decided to admove the premiere date due to unforeseen circumstances.
7. It is common practice to admove certain items for a more streamlined discussion.
8. She asked to admove the deadline for the project to allow more time for research.
9. They will admove the focus of the campaign to better align with audience interests.
10. The board voted to admove the proposal until all members could weigh in on the matter.
