Meaning: ALLOWABLY: In a manner that is permitted or acceptable according to rules or circumstances.

1. She could, allowably, take the extra day off to rest and recover.
2. The committee agreed that the additional expenses were allowably covered by the budget.
3. He was, allowably, late to the meeting due to unforeseen circumstances.
4. The project timeline was adjusted, and the team was allowably given more time to complete their tasks.
5. Allowably, the teacher extended the deadline for assignments due to the recent disruptions.
6. They decided that the adjustments made to the proposal were allowably within the guidelines.
7. She was allowably frustrated, as the changes were made without her input.
8. In this situation, it was allowably permissible to deviate from the standard protocol.
9. The judge ruled that the evidence could be allowably presented in court.
10. Allowably, the guests were permitted to bring their own beverages to the event.
