Meaning: 'Almost' is an adverb meaning very nearly but not quite; it indicates that something was close to happening or being true, but ultimately did not occur.

1. She almost missed her flight due to the traffic.
2. He almost forgot to bring his keys before leaving the house.
3. The project was almost finished, but it still needed some final touches.
4. I almost laughed out loud at the joke he told.
5. They almost reached the summit before the weather turned bad.
6. The cake was almost perfect, but it needed a little more frosting.
7. She almost decided to take a different route to work this morning.
8. We almost ran out of gas on our road trip last weekend.
9. He almost didn't recognize her after all those years.
10. The team almost won the championship last season, falling short in the final game.
