Meaning: Altho (conjunction): a variant spelling of "although," used to introduce a contrast or exception.

2. She enjoys reading fiction, altho she often reads non-fiction as well.
3. Altho the movie received mixed reviews, I found it quite entertaining.
4. I usually prefer tea, altho I occasionally drink coffee.
5. Altho he was tired, he stayed up to finish his project.
6. The restaurant is closed on Sundays, altho it opens early on Saturdays.
7. Altho she is shy, she speaks passionately about her interests.
8. He accepted the challenge, altho he knew it would be difficult.
9. Altho the weather was chilly, we had a wonderful picnic.
10. She smiled altho she felt nervous about the presentation.
