

ANOINTER

Meaning: To anoint is to apply oil or another substance to someone or something as part of a religious or ceremonial rite, often symbolizing consecration or blessing.

1. The priest will anointer the new church with holy oil during the ceremony.
2. In ancient times, leaders were often anointed as a sign of divine approval.
3. She chose to anointer the newborn with blessings for a prosperous life.
4. The ritual required the elder to anointer each participant with sacred fragrance.
5. As part of his coronation, he was anointed with oil from a special vessel.
6. The community gathered to witness the anointer perform the sacred rites.
7. They believed that the anointer could bestow protection and wisdom through the oil.
8. The king's decision to anointer himself symbolized his commitment to his people.
9. To anointer the altar, the priest used a mixture of oils and fragrances.
10. During the festival, it is customary to anointer the statue of the deity with flowers.
