Meaning: Antecedently: adverb meaning prior to a particular event or action; previously.

4. The author antecedently discussed the themes in her earlier works.
5. They had antecedently agreed on the budget before the project began.

7. She antecedently provided the necessary documentation for the application.
8. The teacher antecedently outlined the expectations for the assignment.
9. The team antecedently strategized their approach to the competition.
10. He antecedently acknowledged the contributions of his colleagues in his speech.
