

APPROXIMATION

Meaning: Approximation: a value or quantity that is close to, but not exactly equal to, a specific value, often used to simplify calculations or estimates.

1. The scientist used an approximation to estimate the value of the unknown variable.
2. In mathematics, an approximation can simplify complex calculations significantly.
3. His drawing was more of an approximation than an accurate representation of the landscape.
4. They reached an approximation of the total cost after reviewing all the estimates.
5. The team relied on an approximation of the data to make their decision.
6. Her response was an approximation of what she truly felt about the situation.
7. In physics, approximations are often necessary due to the complexities of real-world scenarios.
