Meaning: Aspersed (verb): to tarnish or damage someone's reputation by making false or misleading statements.

1. The politician aspersed his opponent's character during the debate.
2. She felt hurt when rumors were aspersed about her integrity.

4. His reputation was aspersed by unsubstantiated claims spread by jealous colleagues.
