

ASSAI

Meaning: Assai (adverb) - a musical term meaning "very" or "extremely," used to indicate a heightened degree of intensity or speed in performance.

1. The pianist played the piece with an intensity that was truly assai.
2. In the final movement, the conductor urged the orchestra to play assai faster.
3. The novel's plot thickened assai, drawing readers deeper into the mystery.
4. Her enthusiasm for the project was evident, as she worked assai diligently.
