

ASSUMABLY

Meaning: Assumably means "likely or probably; based on reasonable assumption."

1. She was late to the meeting, assumably due to traffic.
2. The package was delayed, assumably because of bad weather.
3. Assumably, he will arrive by noon, as he mentioned earlier.
4. The results were surprising, assumably reflecting a change in public opinion.
5. She chose the blue dress, assumably because it matched her eyes.
6. Assumably, the project will require more funding than initially planned.
7. He didn't respond to the invitation, assumably because he was busy.
8. Assumably, they will extend the deadline for submissions this year.
9. The movie was a hit, assumably due to its star-studded cast.
10. Assumably, the changes will lead to improved performance in the team.
