Meaning: Assumptive: characterized by an unwarranted belief or presumption that something is true, often without evidence or consideration of other perspectives.

1. The assumptive tone of his argument made it difficult for others to voice their objections.

3. The report was criticized for its assumptive conclusions drawn from limited data.
