

ATTESTATION

Meaning: Attestation is the act of providing formal confirmation or evidence of the authenticity or validity of a document or statement.

1. The lawyer required an attestation of the document's authenticity before proceeding.
2. Her signature served as an attestation of her agreement to the terms outlined in the contract.
3. The university provided an attestation confirming that he had completed all the necessary courses.
4. An attestation from a certified professional can greatly enhance the credibility of your claims.
5. In legal matters, an attestation often signifies witness acknowledgment of a statement or event.
6. The notary public issued an attestation to confirm that the signatures were valid and witnessed.
7. To complete the application, you must include an attestation of your residency.
8. The researcher submitted an attestation to verify the integrity of the data collected during the study.
9. An attestation of eligibility is essential for anyone applying for the scholarship.
10. The board required an attestation from the auditors to ensure financial transparency.
