Meaning: Backdoor: a hidden method of bypassing normal authentication or security controls in a computer system or software.

1. The hacker accessed the system through a backdoor in the software.
2. To enhance security, the IT team removed all known backdoors from the application.
3. She slipped out the backdoor to avoid the crowd gathering in front.
4. The builder installed a backdoor for easy access to the garden from the kitchen.
5. In some cases, backdoor deals can undermine trust in business negotiations.
6. The spy used a backdoor to infiltrate the enemy's communication network.
7. After the storm, they found a backdoor had been left unlocked, allowing water to enter.
8. He argued that the emergency exit was essentially a backdoor for the building.
9. The government was criticized for potentially allowing backdoor surveillance on citizens.
10. They discovered a hidden backdoor in the code that compromised user privacy.
