Meaning: Bastioned: reinforced or protected by a strong structure or foundation, either physically (as in a fortress) or intellectually (as in beliefs).

4. He felt bastioned in his decision after consulting with trusted advisors.
5. The organization bastioned its resources to withstand financial challenges.

7. The army bastioned itself in the valley, preparing for the approaching storm.
8. She bastioned her argument with compelling evidence and expert testimonies.
