Meaning: Batologize (verb): To engage in excessive or meaningless talk.

1. To batologize is to engage in excessive or meaningless talk.
2. His tendency to batologize during meetings often frustrated his colleagues.
3. She would batologize for hours, leaving little room for anyone else to speak.
4. The professor warned his students not to batologize in their essays if they wanted good grades.
