

BEWRAP

Meaning: To bewrap means to cover or enclose something with protective material, often to safeguard it from damage.

1. Please bewrap the fragile items in bubble wrap before packing them.

6. After the holiday season, we always bewrap the decorations to store them safely.
7. She will bewrap the bouquet in beautiful paper for the wedding.
8. It's important to bewrap the electronics properly to avoid any scratches during transit.
9. Before moving, we should bewrap the fragile glassware to ensure it doesn't break.
10. To keep the sandwiches fresh, remember to bewrap them in parchment paper.
