Meaning: Without questioning or understanding the reasons or consequences; in a manner that involves complete trust or lack of awareness.

4. They marched forward blindly, driven by their passion rather than reason.
5. In his excitement, he blindly overlooked the warning signs.
6. The student completed the assignment blindly, relying solely on internet sources.
7. She agreed to the terms blindly, without reading the fine print.
8. He invested his money blindly, trusting the advice of a friend.
9. The dog chased the ball blindly, not noticing the oncoming traffic.
