

BLOWHOLE

Meaning: Blowhole: A specialized opening on the top of a whale's head through which it breathes and expels air and water.

1. The whale surfaced and spouted water from its blowhole.
2. Scientists study the size of a whale's blowhole to understand its breathing patterns.
3. During the tour, we were lucky to see a dolphin use its blowhole to exhale.
4. The blowhole of a sperm whale is located on the left side of its head.
5. When the blowhole is visible, it indicates the whale is about to dive again.
6. A blowhole allows marine mammals to breathe efficiently while swimming.
7. The tour guide explained how the blowhole functions as a nostril for the whale.
8. After the whale surfaced, we watched as water shot from its blowhole.
9. The size and shape of a blowhole can vary significantly between species.
10. Researchers captured stunning footage of a humpback whale breaching and using its blowhole.
