Meaning: To blurt means to say something suddenly and impulsively, often without thinking or intending to reveal it.

1. She didn't mean to blurt out the secret during the meeting.
2. He tends to blurt out whatever comes to his mind, regardless of the consequences.

4. It's important to think before you blurt, especially when emotions are high.
5. During the surprise party, he accidentally blurted out the guest of honor's name.

7. When excited, children often blurt out their wishes without hesitation.
8. She managed to blurt her feelings just before the moment passed.
9. He didn't mean to blurt his opinion in front of everyone.
