

# BRACT

*Meaning: A bract is a modified leaf, often brightly colored, that is associated with a flower or flower cluster and can attract pollinators.*

1. The bract, often mistaken for a petal, plays a crucial role in attracting pollinators.

7. In orchids, the bract can be found encircling the flowering stem, offering support.
