

BRONCHUS

Meaning: Bronchus: one of the two main air passages that branch from the trachea and lead into the lungs.

1. The bronchus branches off from the trachea, leading air into the lungs.
2. Inflammation of the bronchus can lead to bronchitis, causing difficulty in breathing.
3. Each bronchus divides further into smaller bronchi and ultimately into bronchioles.
4. During a medical examination, the doctor listened to the patient's bronchus for any abnormal sounds.
5. Inhaled particles can irritate the bronchus, prompting a protective cough reflex.
6. A bronchus affected by infection may produce excess mucus, obstructing airflow.
7. Surgery on the bronchus may be necessary to remove blockages or damaged tissue.
8. The right bronchus is wider and more vertical than the left, affecting how foreign objects lodge.
9. Radiology can help visualize the bronchus to assess for tumors or other abnormalities.
10. Bronchodilators are often prescribed to relax the muscles around the bronchus in asthma patients.
