Meaning: By-blow: an incidental or secondary effect or consequence resulting from a primary event or situation.

1. The storm was a by-blow of the larger climatic changes affecting the region.
2. His sudden departure was a by-blow to the team's morale and cohesion.
3. The by-blow of her harsh words left him feeling dejected and misunderstood.
4. Although the accident was a by-blow of his negligence, he accepted full responsibility.
5. The new policy changes were a by-blow of recent economic pressures on the company.
6. Their friendship ended as a by-blow of a misunderstanding that spiraled out of control.
7. The artist's latest work was a by-blow of his experiences during his travels abroad.
8. Her decision to leave was a by-blow of the ongoing tensions in the workplace.
