

CANCELLATE

Meaning: Cancellate: to annul or invalidate a formal agreement or order.

2. In order to rectify the mistake, the manager had to cancellate the previous order.
3. The committee voted unanimously to cancellate the event after considering the weather forecast.
4. He was relieved when the company agreed to cancellate his subscription without any penalties.
