Meaning: Causer (noun): a person or thing that brings about or is responsible for an event or situation.

1. The investigation revealed that the causer of the accident was a mechanical failure.
2. Her persistent absence became the causer of tension among the team members.
3. In the debate, he identified the causer of the conflict as a misunderstanding.
4. The scientist wanted to isolate the causer of the disease for further study.
