2. She needed to certify her credentials before applying for the position.
3. The agency is responsible for certify the quality of all exported goods.

5. To operate heavy machinery, you must first certify your skills through training.
6. The notary public is authorized to certify signatures on important documents.
7. They required a licensed inspector to certify the building's safety standards.
8. Before receiving the grant, she had to certify her eligibility through documentation.
9. The school will certify the students' achievements at the graduation ceremony.
10. To ensure authenticity, they hired an expert to certify the artwork's provenance.
