

CESURAL

Meaning: Cesural (adjective): relating to a pause or break in a line of verse or speech that creates a dramatic effect or alters rhythm.

1. The cesural pause in her speech added dramatic effect to her storytelling.
2. In poetry, a cesural break can change the rhythm and pacing of a line.
3. The musician incorporated a cesural moment in the composition to emphasize the melody.
4. His cesural delivery allowed the audience to reflect on the weight of his words.
