

CHALAZION

Meaning: Chalazion: a painless swelling on the eyelid resulting from blockage of an oil gland.

1. A chalazion is a painless lump that forms on the eyelid due to a blocked oil gland.
2. Many people confuse a chalazion with a sty, but they are different conditions.
3. Treatment options for a chalazion may include warm compresses and gentle massage.
4. If a chalazion persists, a doctor might recommend an injection of corticosteroids.
5. Surgical removal of a chalazion is usually considered when other treatments fail.
6. Chalazia can occur in both children and adults, although they are more common in adults.
7. Keeping the eyelid area clean can help prevent the formation of a chalazion.
8. It is important to avoid squeezing a chalazion, as this can lead to infection.
9. Symptoms of a chalazion may include swelling, redness, and tenderness in the eyelid.
10. Many cases of chalazion resolve on their own without medical intervention.
