

CIRCUMBENDIBUS

Meaning: Circumbendibus refers to a roundabout or indirect way of speaking or reasoning that avoids addressing the main point directly.

1. The politician's speech was a circumbendibus, avoiding the main issues while trying to seem comprehensive.
2. Instead of addressing the problem directly, she took a circumbendibus route that left everyone confused.
3. His explanation was a circumbendibus that only added to the ambiguity of the situation.

5. The lawyer's circumbendibus argument was cleverly constructed but ultimately failed to convince the jury.
