Meaning: Circumlocutory refers to a manner of speaking or writing that is unnecessarily lengthy and indirect, often leading to confusion rather than clarity.

1. His circumlocutory explanation left everyone more confused than informed.
2. The author's circumlocutory style made the novel feel unnecessarily long and convoluted.
3. During the debate, her circumlocutory responses failed to address the core issues directly.
4. To avoid confrontation, he often resorted to circumlocutory language in his conversations.
5. The speaker's circumlocutory approach was intended to soften the impact of his criticism.
