

CIRCUMSTANTIALITY

Meaning: Circumstantiality refers to the quality of being based on or dependent upon indirect or inferred evidence rather than direct proof.

1. The circumstantiality of the evidence made it difficult to draw any definitive conclusions.
2. In legal cases, the circumstantiality of witness testimonies can heavily influence the jury's decision.
3. The circumstantiality of his alibi raised questions about his whereabouts during the incident.
4. Her argument was strong, but the circumstantiality of her claims left some doubts in the minds of the listeners.
5. Many critics pointed out the circumstantiality of the plot twists, arguing they felt forced rather than organic.
