

CLAIMANT

Meaning: A claimant is an individual who asserts a right or makes a demand for something, often in a legal context, such as seeking compensation or justice.

1. The claimant presented compelling evidence to support her case in court.

3. As the sole claimant in the dispute, he felt a heavy burden of responsibility.
