Meaning: CLAPS: plural noun referring to the sharp sounds made by striking the palms of the hands together, typically as a form of applause or to gain attention.

2. She claps her hands together to get everyone's attention before starting the meeting.
3. The rhythmic claps of the drums echoed through the concert hall, energizing the crowd.

5. Children often express their joy with loud claps when they see their favorite characters on stage.
