

CLEMENCY

Meaning: Clemency is the act of showing mercy or leniency, especially in the context of reducing a punishment or sentence.

1. The governor granted clemency to the inmates who had shown genuine remorse for their actions.
2. In a surprising turn of events, the judge decided to exercise clemency instead of imposing a lengthy sentence.
3. Clemency is often seen as a sign of mercy in a justice system that can be unforgiving.
