

CLINGSTONE

Meaning: Clingstone refers to a type of fruit, particularly peaches and cherries, in which the flesh adheres closely to the pit, making it challenging to separate them.

1. The juicy peach has a clingstone, making it difficult to separate the flesh from the pit.
