

# CO-LESSEE

*Meaning: Co-lessee: a person who jointly shares the lease agreement and associated responsibilities for a rental property with one or more individuals.*

1. The co-lessee signed the lease agreement to share the rental responsibilities.

3. The landlord required both co-lessees to provide their income information for the application process.
